Today, keeping in mind the pressing need to contribute to arresting the deteriorating environmental parameters in India and the rest of the world **the Health, Safety, Environment & Sustainability (HSES) department of ESL Steel Limited organized a Plantation Drive** on UNEP (United Nations Environment Programme) declared World Environment Day. It was also the culmination of a week-long **Environmental Consciousness, Awareness & Action Week celebrations** in the plant.

This year's theme for World Environment Day is **Land Restoration, Desertification, and Drought Resilience**.

To coincide with this year's World Environment Day Celebration a week-long **Environmental Consciousness**, **Awareness & Action Week** was celebrated in ESL Steel Limited. The "One-point-five" declaration accepted at the 2015 UN Climate Summit in Paris, popularly known as the Paris Agreement means that by the year 2100, all 195 countries, organisations, and individuals must strive to contain the world's average surface temperature to not rise more than 1.5°C than the pre-industrial revolution levels."

He added, "We have pledged to plant 1.5 Lakh plants in 2024/25 and this is our effort towards "One-point-five" declaration. For us, it is an ambitious plan but a small step considering that India must plant around 400 to 500 million plants to contain the effects of climate change. But we are taking our motivation from the oft-repeated poetry by Dushyant Kumar 'Kaise aakash me suraakh naheen ho sakta; Ek patthar to tabeeyat se uchhaalo yaaro' (There are many wonderful things that will never be done if you do not try)."

To coincide with the UNEP declared World Environment Day and the culmination of a week-long Environmental Consciousness, Awareness & Action Week at ESL Steel Limited there was a congregation of around 150 ESL Steel Limited employees which included Mr. Ravish Sharma, COO, ESL Steel Limited; Mr. Anand Dubey, CFO, ESL Steel Limited; Ms. Meenakshi Sabharwal, CQO and Head Business Excellence; Ms. Shyamlee Minz, CHRO where after the lamp lighting a pledge was taken to be environmentally conscious and to help in the ESL Steel Limited's strive towards the ambitious 1.5 lakh plant-strong plantation drive.
